- <u>Barnardos Haven Project</u> offers one-to-one sessions for unaccompanied children, family sessions, schoolbased programmes, and support group Who is it for: children up to age 18 residents of North Lincolnshire
- <u>CAMHS</u> is an NHS service that provides therapy and emotional support for people with mental health challenges. You can find one in every local authority Who is it for: children and young people, including unaccompanied children.
- <u>'HEARTS'</u> project by Children's Society which provides advocacy support and therapeutic support Who is it for: young people aged 15-25 in Leeds.
- <u>Chilypep's Children's Wellbeing Practitioners (CWP)</u> offers several therapeutic and wellbeing services for young people based in South Yorkshire.
 Who is it for: children and young people in Sheffield and Barnsley area.
- <u>Multi- agency Psychological Support for Looked After Children MAPS is a team of professionals who</u> support the mental health.
 Who is it for: children and young people looked after by Sheffield City Council.
- <u>Refugee Council 'My View' and 'My View Remote'</u> also offers therapeutic support which includes up to 12 sessions and has capacity for up to three urgent interventions for those with more complex cases. Who is it for: children between 12 and 17 years who are in Yorkshire and Humber and remotely.
- <u>Refugee Council 'Children and Families Wellbeing Support'</u> provides free specialist child and family therapy service for children, families, and schools.
 Who is it for: the Vulnerable Persons and Children's Resettlement Schemes; the Gateway Protection Programme; the UK Resettlement Scheme and Afghan Resettlement Scheme and are in South Yorkshire.
